\*\*Schedules will not be available if: Returning Student Registration is Incomplete, Immunizations Missing or Verification of Residence needs updating.

**<u>Buljan Athletics:</u>** The following details the RCSD Eligibility Requirements for participating in extracurricular activities including athletics.

- -Students participating in school-sponsored extracurricular activities shall demonstrate positive learning behaviors. Students are expected to not have a total of 6 or more "Rarely" scores.
- -Students are expected to meet school-wide behavior expectations as outlined in the school handbook. The athletic director, club advisor, or Principal designee shall validate if the student is meeting school-wide behavior and learning behavior expectations.
- -If students do not meet the above criteria for participation in any extracurricular activities, the student has the right to appeal the decision to the site administration.

**Students must have the blue "After School Athletic Participation Clearance Form" completed prior to tryouts for any after school athletic program**. Forms are available from the coaches, in the school office, or from the P.E. department. Once the team has been selected, a Field Trip Permission Form will be provided to all students. We are also asking that you consider making a \$50 donation from students who are participating in each season of sport to help cover the costs of participation.

**Girl's Volleyball 7<sup>th</sup> / 8<sup>th</sup>:** Tryouts will begin on or around Tuesday, August 13th.

Flag Football 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>: Tryouts will begin on or around Tuesday, August 13th.

**Cross Country 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>:** Cross Country is <u>not a tryout sport</u>; however, athletic eligibility must still be met. *Cross Country practice* begins on or around Thursday, August 15th.
